

Three Days of Celebration In East Kildonan To Mark Manitoba's Birthday

One of the biggest week-end celebrations to be held in the history of East Kildonan will be staged this week-end by the East Kildonan Centennial Committee.

The three-day celebration will be kicked off Saturday afternoon when an outdoor beer garden will be held in the Centennial Park on Raleigh street from 2:00 p.m. to midnight under the sponsorship of the East Kildonan Lions.

Entertainment will be provided throughout the ten-hour period.

Festivities will get underway bright and early Sunday morning when a family pancake and sausage breakfast will be held in the Centennial Park from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. This event will be sponsored by the Elmwood-Kildonan 'Y', adults .70¢, children .50¢. There will be warm milk for children.

The beer garden will again be in operation at the Centennial Park from 1:00 to 6:00 p.m. This will again be under the Lions Club.

The closing event for Sun-

day will be free swimming at the 'Y' from 5:00 to 10:00 p.m. The only stipulation to this event will be that children under eight years must be accompanied by an adult.

Monday morning will open with a huge parade at 10:00 a.m. This will assemble at the Munroe Shopping Centre, parade down Munroe avenue, north on Henderson Highway to Fraser's Grove Park.

The parade, which will have over 50 floats entered is under the chairmanship of Captain Arthur Braybrook. Parade Marshal will be Lieut. Thomas Orum.

All the events on Monday will be staged at Fraser's Grove Park. Following is the day's schedule:

12:00 noon- Canoe race from Bronx Park to Fraser's Grove. Anyone may compete but competitors are asked to try and supply their own canoe as the 'Y' only has a limited number. Entry forms may be obtained at the Elmwood-Kildonan 'Y'. For further information phone the 'Y' at 338-0331.

2:15--Official welcome.

2:30--Family games (peanut scramble, treasure hunt, etc.) under the direction of the East Kildonan Department of Parks and Recreation.

3:30--Y.M.C.A. exhibition.

2:00-7:00 p.m. Boat trips on the Paddle Wheelers from Fraser's Grove Park at 50¢ each. Senior Citizens over 65 years may pick up free tickets at Fraser's Grove Park.

5:00-7:00--Family picnic at the park. Bring a basket lunch.

7:00--Elmwood-Kildonan 'Y' exhibition.

7:30-8:00--Family singing.

8:00-9:30--Entertainment on stage.

10:15 p.m.--Giant fireworks display.

The young people will wind things up Monday night over at the Centennial Park with a giant wiener roast and entertainment for teenagers from 9:00 p.m. to midnight.
