

Meet Favors Home-School Associations

East Kildonan will have nine new Home and School Associations shortly, it was decided at a public meeting Tuesday night in Melrose School.

The meeting was called to hear Mrs. R. E. H. Armstrong, provincial organizer of Home and School Associations and to discuss the formation of a Home and School Association. Over 300 residents attended.

It was felt that one association covering all schools in the municipality would be too unwieldy and that it would be more advantageous if each school had its own association as problems pertaining to elementary schools would differ considerably from higher grade schools.

Mrs. Armstrong told the meeting that a Home and School Association was not a social organization, money-sectarian group. "It is also not a sectarian group. "It is also not a place to beef but where parent and teacher can meet together and discuss their problems," she said.

Cam Landreith was chairman for the meeting. Councillor Bruce Bodie brought greetings from the council and L. A. McMahon, chairman of the school board, for that body.
