

# Imperial Bank of Canada Plans Extension To Kildonan Branch

Imperial Bank of Canada, East Kildonan branch, is extending its building at Melrose and Henderson Highway 35 feet to provide four savings wickets and needed space for customers and staff.

Work on the excavation for the extension started on Saturday. General contractors are L. J. Ducharme; architects, Northwood, Chivers, Chivers & Casey.

The original staff of two when the branch opened May 15, 1950, now has grown to 11.

The office has been fully mechanized with the recent installation of a larger ledger posting machine.

Manager of the branch is J. B. Schmor.

The present building is a one-storey brick and stone structure, with a frontage of 40 feet. The exterior design is modern in treatment and enhances the corner where it is located.

The interior of the building corresponds to the modernistic treatment of the exterior with pleasing decoration, oak counters and furnishings and up-to-date fluorescent lighting.

The floors are of rubber tile in the public office and Marbolium covering the work space. The building is heated by oil with automatic controls on the forced hot air system.

The color scheme is pastel green and the fluorescent lighting puts the finishing touches on a very modern office.
