

OPEN SCHOOL IN EAST KILDONAN

Hon. Dr. Thornton Officiates at Ceremony in New \$60,000 Structure

Hon. R. S. Thornton, minister of education, formally opened the new Prince Edward school in East Kildonan at 3.15 this afternoon. Prior to the formal declaration that the school was opened the pupils gave a short program.

Hugh McNair, chairman of the school board, presided and introduced the minister of education. Among those attending were members of the East Kildonan school board and of the municipal council. Rev. H. J. Robertson, of John Black Memorial Presbyterian church, and Rev. J. A. Shirley, of St. Stephen's Anglican church, were present also.

It was stated that about 300 pupils will attend the new school, which is an 8-roomed, one-story, brick structure of pleasing design. Its cost was about \$60,000.

Enrolment began Tuesday and classes will assemble Thursday morning.
