

# EAST KILDONAN COUNCIL HONORS S. R. HENDERSON

## Makes Presentation On His Retirement From Reeveship

S. R. Henderson, reeve of the municipality of East Kildonan, was honored by his fellow members on his retirement from the official chair last night. For a period of five years, before the municipality was divided into east and west, he had been reeve and for the six years following—a continuous period of 11 years—he has filled the important office.
