

## Search May Cost \$10,000

# East Kildonan Plans Search For Water Loss

East Kildonan Council, at a special meeting Tuesday night, moved to spend approximately \$10,000 in an effort to find an unaccountable loss of water in its mains.

Council was informed the city is losing about 33 per cent of its water. It was moved that Search & Supply Western be engaged immediately to find the leak or leaks.

If the abnormally high loss — 33 per cent — could be reduced to a normal 20 per cent — then this would save the city about \$15,000 a year.

The company will employ electronic equipment to determine where the leaks are and will advise the city immediately. The worst ones will be repaired first.

It is expected that considerable amount of the trouble will be found in the older areas where the mains have been down 50 and 60 years.

Council will make application to the Utility Board to use up to \$10,000 from the Replacement Reserve Fund.

## "Kathy" Fund Over \$4,000

It was reported at a recent meeting of the Lions Club of East Kildonan that over \$4,000 has now been subscribed to the "Help Kathy" fund.

The purpose of this special fund was for a kidney transplant from a mother to her daughter, Kathy.

The mother and daughter left Winnipeg March 17th and the satisfactory operation was performed in Denver, Col., April 25th.

Joe Mackenzie, treasurer of the East Kildonan Club, reported he visited Kathy and her mother in Denver a week or so ago and both are anxious to get back home.
