# St. Alphonsus has come a long way

St. Alphonsus Credit Union has come a long way since it was organized in 1938. It was the seventh credit union to receive a charter after provincial legislation was enacted (in 1938) to govern credit union operations in Manitoba.

For many years, business was conducted one evening per week, usually from a classroom in St. Alphonsus School. In spite of the restricted hours, the operation made steady progress.

In order to provide

broader services and longer hours to service its members and potential members, fulltime operations were undertaken in 1969.

The credit union is now preparing for the official opening at its Henderson Highway branch. Present membership exceeds 2,500, with assets of over five million dollars.



**JUNE CAMERON**, branch manager, has been with St. Alphonsus Credit Union since 1969. She was promoted to assistant manager in 1972 and in 1977 became branch manager.

Mrs. Cameron is an East Kildonan resident.
