

Students Driver-Training Classes Start

A driver-training program was instituted by the River East School Division No. 9 and was first commenced last month.

The first class was made up of grade 12 students who are now completing their course of 24 hours classroom instruction and eight hours car-training. This will be followed by the grade 11 classes commencing early in March.

The cars were donated free of charge by Eastern Sales and Community Chevrolet Oldsmobile Ltd.

The instructors are Mr. Melvin Witwnicki, from the Miles Macdonell Collegiate teaching staff, and Mr. George Toth and Mr. John Vaderna of the Toth Driving School.

The students pay a fee of \$30 to cover the costs only and
