

Weekend of nostalgia in store at Miles Mac

Former students and staff of Miles Macdonell Collegiate are invited to participate in a weekend of socializing and nostalgia November 4 and 5, in celebration of Miles Mac's 25th anniversary.

Events planned to celebrate the occasion include a registration evening, fashion show and dance revue, open house, and a "25th anniversary gala" at the Convention Centre.

Registration will start at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, November 4, with the official opening following at 8 p.m. James E. Scarrow, the school's first principal (1952-1967), will be on hand to declare the celebrations officially open.

Rick Burzynski, a Miles Mac alumnus of 1976 and former school president, is the anniversary committee chairman. The committee consists of six former students of the school, one of whom is presently a teacher there.

Entertainment will start at 8:30 p.m., with a slide presentation depicting school life during the past 25 years. A fashion and dance revue will run simultaneously.

Refreshments will be served from 9-11 p.m. "We'll serve punch, since the River East school board denied the serving of alcoholic beverages for the occasion," said Shirley Dudeck, a teacher and former alumnus of Miles Macdonell.

An open house will be held at the school from 2:30-5 p.m. on Saturday, November 5. Former and present teachers will be on hand to greet visitors.

A meeting has been set tentatively for 3 p.m. on November 5 to organize an alumni association.

"If we're successful in establishing an alumni association, we will set up a scholarship fund to commemorate Miles Mac's 25th anniversary," Miss Dudeck said.

The highlight of the weekend — the "25th anniversary gala" — will be held at the Winnipeg Convention Centre starting at 8 p.m. on November 5, with dancing to a 10-piece orchestra, socializing, and a buffet luncheon.
